

September 11, 2012
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Vincent and Stewart along with 11 residents. A moment of silence was held in memory of 9/11. The minutes from the regular meeting on August 14, 2012 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey. Stewart made a motion to approve the treasurer's report with Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Stewart made a motion to approve the monthly bills as presented with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Enforcement officer's report accepted as presented.

The Zoning Administrator was present to inform residents that DTE has filed an amended site plan. There will be a Special Meeting of the Planning Commission on September 18, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. at the Hall.

In citizens comments a resident asked about the Frontier Bill and if the changes had been made to the long distance service. Trustee Stewart assured that the changes had been made and there has been a savings. Chief Skelton inquired about the leak in the roof at the fire hall. Supervisor Gill informed Skelton that the leak was not in the roof but in the vents and they have been repaired. Residents had concerns regarding the amount of chloride and how late it was being applied. Gill recommended that any resident with complaints call the County to complain. The county has hired a new company and they should know about complaints the residents have. A resident asked when the metal benches will be installed. Ramsey informed the resident that John Engel has told her he would be able to install this month.

In new business Stewart made a motion to approve two (2) PA 116's – Farmland and Open Space Preservation Program. Gill seconding. Roll Call: Yes – Ramsey, Gill, O'Brien, Stewart, Vincent.

Stewart presented quotes from Best Buy, ABC Warehouse and Techman Computers for the replacement of the Zoning Administrator's and Treasurer's computers. In 2013 the BS&A will require both computers be replaced because it will no longer work on the Operating System for either computer. The Zoning Administrator's computer has crashed and needs to be replaced immediately. Gill made a motion to purchase 2 computers for the Zoning Administrator and Treasurer from Techman Computers in the amount of \$1,140.00. O'Brien seconding. Roll Call: Yes – O'Brien, Gill, Ramsey, Stewart, Vincent.

Stewart made a motion to adjourn, Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
