

December 10, 2013
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 5 residents. Gill requested to remove discussion on McBride contract and discussion regarding the fire truck hose testing pending reports from Waterway from the agenda. The minutes from the regular meeting on November 12, 2013 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Stewart made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Gill discussed the fire truck inspection and recommendations for repairs. Approval was given by the board for Supervisor Gill to meet with another company for a second opinion on recommended repairs and to repair recent necessary equipment failures in order to put the truck back in service.

Gill discussed actions being taken by the Ordinance Officer on the demolished building on Fargo Road.

In citizens comments a resident has concerns regarding debris in road from building on Fargo Road. A resident had questions regarding the Karegnondi Water Line.

In old business Stewart made a motion to replace 2 ballasts, purchase 2 cases of 15 bulbs and to repair a light out at fire hall. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In new business the board approved for Kenockee Township to store a trailer and generator at the Greenwood Fire Hall. Stewart offered Resolution 2013-3 – Greenwood Township's At Large Assessment for the Improvement of the Fuslein Drain. Resolution was supported by Jonseck. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; Ramsey – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill discussed the Third Street lawsuit and the possible actions that the township can take. Stewart made a motion to choose the No filing option. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. The board approved for Gill to discuss the Lett Cemetary with the attorney.

In citizens comments residents discussed repairs at DTE plant and ITC.

Stewart made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
