

**August 12, 2014**  
**Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on August 12, 2014 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 4 residents. The minutes from the regular meeting on July 8, 2014 and Special Meeting of the Election Commission on July 10, 2014 were approved as presented.

In correspondence Gill gave an update on the Quit Claim for the cemetery. Gill read the letter she received from Prosecutor Wendling regarding the Attorney General's opinion. In the letter Prosecutor Wendling stated that he would not be forwarding the information to the Attorney General. Approval was given by the board for Supervisor Gill to contact Attorney James Dubay and follow through with this situation. Gill announced that ITC had donated and delivered poles to Greenwood Township for the future bridge project.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey.

O'Brien made a motion to approve the outstanding bills as presented with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department report was approved as presented.

The Enforcement Officer's report was approved as presented. Gill discussed current enforcement issues.

Zoning Administrator Arlene Johnson announced that the Planning Commission voted to recommend that the township pass the sign ordinance language.

In new business Gill made a motion to appoint Linda Conrad to the Planning Commission. Linda will fulfill the remainder of John Schoen's term who has passed away. The term ends December 2015. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill offered Resolution 2014-6 Opposing the Construction of a Nuclear Waste Repository in the Great Lakes Basin. Jonseck supporting. Roll Call: Ramsey-yes; Jonseck-yes; Gill-yes; Stewart-yes; O'Brien-yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to change Doug Huston back to employee status. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Jonseck made a motion to purchase a plat book from the St Clair County Conservation District in the amount of \$36.80. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to adopt Sign Ordinance 01-2014 as recommended by the Planning Commission. Ramsey supporting. Roll Call: Jonseck-yes; Gill-yes; Ramsey-yes; Stewart-yes; O'Brien-yes. Motion carried 5-0. O'Brien made a motion to approve the 6" fly over from St Clair County. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizen's comments a resident discussed that Kenockee Township Fire Department has received a grant.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn, with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
