

February 11, 2014
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 5 residents. The minutes from the regular meeting on January 14, 2014 and the Special Meeting on January 30, 2014 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Stewart made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The fire report was approved as presented. Doug Nowicki recommended Jim Rutledge do the filter and oil changes on the Greenwood Township generator and fluorescent bulbs for the fire hall. The fire hose that failed the hose testing will be destroyed.

Gill discussed a possible ordinance enforcement issue.

No citizens comments.

In new business O'Brien made a motion to amend the budget placing \$2,200.00 in Assessing from the Township Hall Miscellaneous account. Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to reappoint Bette Donaldson, John Schoen, Mike Walsh and Marvin Roberts to the Planning Commission for a term of 3 years. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to allow all board members, planning commission members, Zoning board of appeals members and the Zoning Administrator to attend the 2014 St. Clair County Metropolitan Planning Commission Workshop on March 26, 2014. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Jonseck made a motion to amend the Greenwood Township Fee Schedule to reflect the charge for the Zoning Ordinance Books to be the cost of printing rounded up to the nearest dollar amount. Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart offering Resolution 2014-1 to accept the Federal Poverty Exemptions Guidelines for the year 2014, and to adopt an asset level test. Supported by Ramsey. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes, Stewart – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
