

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Clerk O'Brien at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Treasurer Ramsey, Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 6 residents. Clerk O'Brien made a motion for Trustee Stewart to conduct the meeting. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Trustee Stewart requested to add the annual meeting dates to the agenda. The treasurer's report, outstanding bills, and the minutes from the regular meeting on December 10, 2013 and the minutes from the special meeting on December 13, 2013 were approved as presented.

A resident stated that 1 SCBA tank needs to be serviced. Stewart will discuss with Keith Berg. A resident discussed the repair of the Ventilation fan. The repair has been approved by Supervisor Gill for Jim Rutledge to repair the fan at the request of Keith Berg..

Stewart announced that there will be a Planning Commission Meeting on January 15, 2014 at 7:30 p.m.

In old business Ramsey made a motion to replace 50 feet of fire hose to replace the hose that failed the hose test. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Stewart made a motion to repair the lights outside the fire hall. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In new business O'Brien made a motion to order 10 Zoning Ordinance books from Montgomery & Associates not to exceed \$250.00. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Stewart made a motion for Board of Review members, Regular Board members and the Assessors to attend an MTA Webcast for Board of Review training. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Jonseck made a motion to approve the meeting dates as presented for the year 2014. The Regular Board Meeting dates for 2014 will be February 11, March 11, April 8, May 13, June 10, July 8, August 12, September 9, October 14, November 11, December 9, January 13 2015. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In citizens comments a resident asked about some repairs on the fire truck and would like the board to check the spotlight and the light on the tower of fire truck. A resident asked about the old hoses on fire truck and salt for the fire hall.

Stewart made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
