

June 10, 2014
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on June 10, 2014 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 4 residents, Zoning Administrator Arlene Johnson and Laura Newsome from the St Clair County Council on Aging.

The minutes from the regular meeting on May 13, 2014 were approved as presented.

In correspondence Gill discussed the Bill regarding the Nuclear Repository and the EVIP Bill.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey.

Jonseck made a motion to approve the outstanding bills as presented with Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department report was approved as presented.

Gill announced that she attended a hearing with the Magistrate regarding a current enforcement issue. Gill requested permission from the board to speak to Attorney James Dubay about possible Circuit court action. Stewart made a motion to grant permission. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Zoning Administrator Arlene Johnson would like to encourage residents to display addresses

Laura Newsome from the St Clair County Council on Aging was present to discuss the Senior Citizens' Operation millage renewal. Laura stressed that the millage is a renewal only.

In old business O'Brien made a motion for the fire department to hire Yale Electric to repair 3 emergency lights and 3 exit lights at the fire hall. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill discussed the Bid specifications and notice for the asphalt walking trails on the township property. Stewart made a motion to approve bid specifications and notice for paper. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Ramsey made a motion to approve the application for the soil erosion permit. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to purchase a second voting booth for elections. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to pay the 2014/2015 MTA dues. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In new business O'Brien made a motion to approve the 2014 Request for Local Millage Distribution application from the St Clair County Parks and Recreation. Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to change Custodian Doug Huston's employee status to Independent Contractor for the same rate of pay. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to contract FireCATT to perform ladder and hose

testing for Truck #36. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill requested permission to hire Attorney James Dubay to get an Attorney General's opinion regarding the St Clair County Commissioners borrowing money from St Clair County Parks and St Clair County Library since they both have dedicated millages. Stewart made a motion. Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Jonseck made a motion to have the locks changed at the fire hall. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizen's comments the ITC appreciation luncheon and the recreation plan from previous years were discussed.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn, with Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 8:38 p.m.
