Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on April 12, 2016 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern, Todd Burch from the St Clair County Road Commission and 7 residents. The minutes of the previous meeting on March 10, 2016 were approved with a correction to the spelling of Fisher Road.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Jonseck made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department Report was approved as presented.

The Enforcement Officer's Report was approved as presented.

The Zoning Administrator discussed the Planning Commission meeting on April 20th and the Zoning Board of Appeals meeting on April 21st.

Citizen's comments were heard.

Gill made a motion to approve 2 contracts for limestone. Stewart seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, O'Brien – yes, Stewart - yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve a contract for gravel. Ramsey seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, O'Brien – yes, Stewart – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve 3 contracts for mowing, chloride and replacement of a failed cross road culverts. Jonseck seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, O'Brien – yes, Stewart - yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve six ditching contracts. Stewart seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, O'Brien – yes, Stewart - yes. Motion carried 5-0. Todd from the St Clair County Road Commission announced that the County will be offering the \$10,000.00 in funds which he will be putting towards ditching. Gill made a motion to add Friday office hours 10:00 am – 2:00 pm for a 6 month trial period. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve adding a newsletter in the summer tax bills. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. The Board decided to get estimates for the replacement of the roof on the pavilion both for shingles or metal at the request of a resident. The Board decided to look at the inventory of the tables and chairs in the hall and determine a need for replacements. Stewart made a motion to pay the training for the Building Inspector. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0

In citizen's comments a resident asked questions regarding the hall rental policy. The zoning administrator was present to inform the resident that the hall is not zoned to rent for for-profit business purposes.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
