Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on June 14, 2016 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck along with Zoning Administrator Jeffery Kern and 9 residents. Trustee Stewart was absent. The minutes of the previous Regular meeting on May 10, 2016 were approved as presented. Ramsey requested adding the security box to new business.

In correspondence Ramsey discussed the St Clair County Foreclosure list.

The treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The Zoning Administrator discussed an enforcement issue.

In citizens comments a resident asked a question regarding property taxes. Gill asked the resident to call the Assessor.

In new business O'Brien made a motion to renew the annual contract with Michigan Township Association for 2016-2017. Gill seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes. Stewart – absent. Motion carried 4-0. Gill made a motion to start legal action on a current enforcement issue if there has been no improvement in the next 30 days. Jonseck seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien - yes. Stewart absent. Motion carried 4-0. Ramsey discussed repairing the parking lot posts instead of replacing. It was agreed to discuss the issue at a later meeting. Ramsey made a motion to have Owen Tree Service deliver and install playground mulch if the mulch is certified for playgrounds. If the mulch is not certified the board will use Jack Golden Associates, Inc.. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Ramsey discussed having a former treasurer sign papers at CSB regarding the township security box for current board members to have access.

In citizens comments residents discussed the street lights at Fargo and Hewitt, chloride, links on the website. Greenwood Little League board member Pete Bullard was present to thank the Greenwood Township Board for the use of the Baseball fields.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
