Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Roberts and Krikorian. Also present were 13 residents and Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern. Nowicki made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting on November 14, 2017. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In correspondence Nowicki read a letter received from Ray & Arlene Johnson thanking the volunteer responders for their skills, speed and professionalism with a tragic event involving their grandson.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved as presented.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Nowicki discussed that Apollo is waiting for the parts to repair Truck 36.

In the Zoning Administrator's Report there will be a Planning Commission meeting on January 17, 2018. The Zoning Administrator stated that the amendment to the Wind ordinance has been sent to the Township attorney and Planner.

In citizen's comments residents discussed wind farms in Sebawing, drains and solar farms.

In new business Nowicki made a motion to approve materials for Jim Rutledge to do annual maintenance on the small engines at the fire hall and the purchase of 2 halogen bulbs. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments residents had questions regarding the renewal of the Kenockee Fire Contract.

Nowicki made a motion adjourn. Ramsey seconding.
