

July 11, 2017
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Roberts and Krikorian. Also present were 6 residents and Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern. Nowicki made a motion to approve the previous meeting on June 13, 2017. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Nowicki discussed receiving correspondence from CLOSUP (Center for Local, State, and Urban Policy). Nowicki recommended having them come to a Planning Commission meeting where they will give a free presentation regarding the benefits and drawbacks of wind energy. The Board members agreed.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved as presented.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the monthly bills as presented. Nowicki seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

The Zoning Administrator announced the Planning Commission meeting on July 19, 2017 at 7:30 p.m.

In citizens comments a resident had a question regarding the new fire chief at Kenockee Fire Department.

In new business Nowicki made a motion to pay FireCatt for the hose and ladder testing once the invoice is corrected by FireCatt. Greenwood Township passed the ladder testing and hose testing. An error was discovered in the invoice pertaining to the amount of hose that was billed to Greenwood Township. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. O'Brien made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-5 allowing the Greenwood Township Clerk to submit the Grant Application for the new voting system. Ramsey seconding. Roll Call: Nowicki – yes; Krikorian – yes; Ramsey – yes; Roberts – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments questions were asked regarding wind turbines and the drain assessment for Plum Creek.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
