

May 9, 2017
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Roberts and Krikorian. Also present were 10 residents and Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern. Teri Wilmoth was present to give a presentation on behalf of the St Clair County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. Ramsey requested to add to new business the discussion regarding the hot water tank and softener.

Krikorian made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting on April 11, 2017. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

No correspondence.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved as presented.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the monthly bills as presented. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

There was no enforcement officer's report.

The Zoning Administrator announced that there is a Zoning Board of Appeals meeting on May 25th at 7:30 pm to hear a request for a variance. The Zoning Administrator also stated that he received a call from Tradewinds who will be submitting a Request for a Special use permit for a MET tower.

In citizens comments questions were asked regarding the Kenockee Fire Chief position and the representation from the Greenwood Township Board at the St Clair County Meeting for Wind farm projects.

In new business Teri Wilmoth gave a presentation on behalf of the St Clair County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management for Emergency Readiness. A question was asked regarding the purchase of a backup generator at the Township Hall. Nowicki made a motion for Jim Vincent to weed the flower beds at the Township for \$100.00. The Township will provide the mulch not to exceed \$50.00. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Nowicki made a motion to accept the proposal from Midwest Metal Construction to remove and replace the drywall at the Fire Hall in the amount of \$2,335.00. Roberts seconding. Roll Call: Krikorian – yes; Nowicki – yes; Roberts – yes; O'Brien – yes. Ramsey abstaining. Motion carried 4-0. Ramsey made a motion to have Yale Electric replace the outside pole lights with LED. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Nowicki made a motion to repair or replace as needed

the hot water tank at the hall. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Nowicki will add salt to the water softener.

In citizens comments questions were asked regarding the dust from the newly graded roads, timeline for the application of chloride and the amount of limestone in the center of Duce.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
