

**September 12, 2017**  
**Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Roberts and Krikorian. Also present were 6 residents, Curtis McBride and Samantha Hudson from McBride & Manley and Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern. Nowicki made a motion to approve the previous meeting on August 8, 2017. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Nowicki discussed receiving correspondence from the St Clair County Drain Commission regarding the Jackson Drain, Pipeline Association, Public Service Commission regarding DTE and Semco, Michigan State Department of Treasury and the AMAR approval of the Township and the Par Plan regarding a recurring grant.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved as presented.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern announced there will be a Planning Commission meeting on September 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm regarding wind energy. There will also be a Zoning Board of Appeals meeting on September 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:30 pm regarding a variance request.

No citizens comments.

In new business McBride & Manley were present to discuss the Greenwood Township audit. During the presentation McBride & Manley discussed the audit process with the Board and the residents. Greenwood Township received a clean audit report. McBride & Manley also stated that Greenwood Township has a healthy fund balance. Copies of the audit are available in the Township office. Nowicki made a motion to refund a hall rental deposit from 2011. The rental was paid for by money order and it was lost. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Nowicki offered Resolution 2017-6 - 2018 Local Road System Funding Assistance Program Application. Supported by O'Brien. Roll Call Krikorian – yes; Nowicki –yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes. Roberts abstaining. Motion carried 4-0. The pump test was performed on Truck #36. No invoice has been received. The Board discussed and approved the reimbursement of Permit bond refunds and Hall Rental Deposits between regular scheduled board meetings. Nowicki made a motion to stop the grounds cleanup for the season in October with the final day being the next scheduled regular board meeting. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments questions were asked regarding the Planning Commission meeting time and the building on Hewitt.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
