

**February 13, 2018**  
**Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present were Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustee Roberts. Trustee Krikorian was absent. Also present were 9 residents and Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern. Nowicki added repairs to the front sign and O'Brien added election supplies to the agenda. Nowicki made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting on January 9, 2018. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In correspondence Nowicki discussed receiving correspondence regarding a possible increase in state garbage fees, meeting with St Clair County Road Commission, and Nickel & Saph sponsoring Greenwood Township members for the State of the County meeting.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved as presented.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

In the Zoning Administrator's Report there will be a Planning Commission Public Hearing regarding the amendment to the wind ordinance on February 21, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. The Greenwood Township attorney and planners will be in attendance.

In citizen's comments a resident asked questions regarding the increase in garbage fees per ton.

In new business Nowicki made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-1 to waive interest and penalty associated with untimely & not filed property transfer affidavits. O'Brien supporting. Roll Call: Nowicki – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes; Roberts – yes. Krikorian absent. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-2 authorizing the Greenwood Township Board of Review to accept the Federal poverty exemptions for the year 2018. Ramsey supporting. Roll Call: Roberts – yes; O'Brien – yes; Ramsey – yes; Nowicki – yes. Krikorian absent. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve the 2018 Asset Level Test. Roberts seconding. Roll Call: Nowicki – yes; O'Brien – yes; Ramsey – yes; Roberts – yes. Krikorian absent. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve the Board of Trustees, Planning Commission and the Zoning Board of Appeals to attend the 2018 St Clair County Metropolitan Planning Commission annual workshop. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve the Building permit fees for solar. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0. O'Brien made a motion to amend the budget in the amount of \$500.00 from the Township miscellaneous to Street Lights. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to appoint Scott Ramsey as an alternate on Zoning Board of Appeals. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to have Yale Electric repair the lights on the sign at the township for up to \$300.00. Anything above \$300.00 will be discussed at the next meeting. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. O'Brien made a motion to approve the purchase election supplies. The supplies would include the famous names demo kits for both the ICP and ICX, thermal paper rolls, ICX blank stubbed ballots, and the ICX shield. Nowicki seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In citizens comments residents had questions regarding garbage pickup.

Nowicki made a motion adjourn. Ramsey seconding.
