Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular Greenwood Township Board Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Trustees Roberts and Krikorian. Treasurer Ramsey was absent. Also present were 6 residents.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on June 12, 2018. Roberts seconding. Motion seconding 4-0.

In correspondence O'Brien discussed receiving confirmation that the township was approved for the 2018 St Clair County Parks & Recreation millage distribution.

The treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the monthly bills as presented. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

The Enforcement officer's report was approved as presented.

In citizen's comments residents had questions regarding the Greenwood Township Millage Renewal and the application of limestone on the roads.

In new business Nowicki made a motion to approve Yale Electric to replace outlets and install new ground wires in the kitchen and hall. Krikorian seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki discussed putting together bid packages and sending to the attorney. O'Brien made a motion to approve paying Michigan Wildlife Solutions, LLC for bat exclusion, removal, sealing and caulking. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki was approved to purchase spray for ants. Nowicki will be getting estimates to replace a failed fire hose. Nowicki made a motion to approve moving the annual maintenance for Truck 37 to August per Brockway Chief Hubbard's request. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve purchasing election supplies. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In citizens comments residents had questions regarding county mowing, wind turbines & solar and the ordinance, and ditching on Oatman Road.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn. Krikorian seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
