

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Board members present Supervisor Nowicki, Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien, Trustee Roberts and Trustee Krikorian along with 21 residents. Also present were Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern, 2 representatives from Geronimo Energy, Jim Brown and a representative from Nickel & Saph Insurance. The agenda, the minutes of the previous meeting of April 10, 2018, outstanding bills, treasurer's report and the fire department report were approved as presented.

In correspondence Nowicki discussed receiving correspondence from Geronimo regarding fencing, DTE regarding the Public Service Commission and active shooter training.

The Zoning Administrator stated that the Zoning Board of Appeals will be meeting on May 9, 2018 at 7:30 p.m for a variance request by Geronimo Energy. Geronimo Energy was present to thank the Planning Commission for the approval of the Special Land Use permit.

In citizens' comments a resident asked a question about the mowing for the Township. The day of cutting has been changed to Thursday.

In new business the board approved for Nowicki to repair or replace the door knob on the utility room in the hall and the garage door. Nowicki made a motion to approve the replacement of the East Gable light by Yale Electric. Krikorian seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Ramsey made a motion to approve the Cemetery Contract for \$1.00. Krikorian seconding. Roberts and Nowicki abstaining. Motion carried 3-0. The board approved receiving bids for the repair or replacement of one section and the full sidewalk. Nowicki made a motion to purchase mulch up to \$30.00. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve the installment of wing tips on 2 baseball fields. O'Brien seconding. Krikorian abstaining. Motion carried 4-0. Krikorian made a motion to approve a one year fire contract with Brockway Township. Roberts seconding. Roll Call: Krikorian – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes; Roberts – yes. Nowicki abstaining. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion to approve paying the Custodian 25 hours per month plus 1 hour per rental. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizen's comments residents had questions regarding the fire contract for both Kenockee and Brockway, equipment, costs and hall rentals.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn, with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
