

**September 11, 2018
Greenwood Township
Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular Greenwood Township Board Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Nowicki at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustee Roberts. Trustee Krikorian was absent. Also present were 7 residents, Zoning Administrator Jeff Kern and John Johnson from Nickel & Saph, Inc.

The agenda was approved as presented.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on August 14, 2018. Ramsey seconding. Motion seconding 4-0.

No correspondence.

The treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Nowicki made a motion to approve the monthly bills as presented. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The fire department report was approved as presented.

The Enforcement officer's report was approved as presented.

In citizen's comments a resident thanked the Road Commission for the application of chloride after grading.

In new business Nowicki made a motion to approve Midwest Metal Construction to repair the siding at the fire hall. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki made a motion for Mike Walsh to deliver limestone for the area of the picnic tables up to \$400.00. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Nowicki to get quotes for a K12 saw for the fire truck. No bids were received for the sidewalks. Nowicki made a motion to repair sidewalk up to \$100.00 and open the bid process again in the spring. Roberts seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Mike Walsh will be removing weeds from the ditch. O'Brien offered Resolution 2018-9 2019 Local Road System Funding Assistance Program. Nowicki supporting. Roll Call: Nowicki – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes. Roberts abstaining. Motion carried 3-0. O'Brien made a motion to repair or replace the front office chair. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0. John Johnson was present to present a quote for insurance from Nickel & Saph, Inc.

In citizens comments Keith Berg requested a moment of silence in honor of 9/11. A resident had questions regarding mailbox vandalism, bats and the painting of the garage. A resident who could not attend asked Treasurer Ramsey to discuss some hall maintenance questions. The resident feels that some updating and repairs needs to be done at the hall and the board agrees and will be getting quotes and prepare the budget for next year to update and repair.

Nowicki made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
