
Road and Ditching Contracts

This year the Greenwood Township Board approved the following road contracts:

- 29 loads of 22 A limestone aggregate at approximately 52 tons per load equals 1,404 tons (the full cost will be billed to the township)
 - 25 loads of 22 A limestone aggregate at approximately 52 tons per load equals 1,352 tons (Greenwood Township will only pay 20% of the total cost because of a special county program)
 - 51 loads of 23 A gravel at approximately 52 tons per load equals 2,392 tons
 - 2 solid applications of 21% calcium chloride will be applied. The first application will be applied after the gravel is in place at a rate of 3,000/4,000 gallons per mile, the second application will be at a rate of 2,000/3,000 gallons per mile.
 - Mowing a second and third pass on all local roads to provide clear vision for the motoring public
 - Replace failed cross road culverts when necessary as approved by the supervisor
