The Treasurer's Report

Summer Property Taxes are due **September 14th**. Office hours on Thursday, September 14, will be from 9 to 5. Payments can be made by mail or at the Greenwood Hall during normal business hours. Payments can also be made at CSB Bank in Yale. Sorry, **we CANNOT accept payments in cash, by credit card, or over the phone.** Payments made after September 14th will automatically have 1% interest added each month. For example, September is 1%, October is 2%, etc. Payments made by mail must be postmarked by September 14th.

Winter property taxes will be mailed out by December 1st and are due by Tuesday, February 28, 2018. The office will be open February 28 from 8:30 am to 5 pm. **Payments made after this date have to be made at the county. *Please call the township office before going to the county to make sure the tax rolls have been turned over.** Taxes that are turned over to the county receive an automatic 5% penalty plus the 1% interest per month. Payments made by mail **MUST** be postmarked by February 28th.

Summer tax deferment forms will be available after July 1st. Forms can either be filled out at the office or one can be mailed out on request. Forms **MUST** be filled out no later than September 15th. Please call the office if you are interested in applying because certain requirements have to be met in order to qualify.

Burning Permits

This summer you may be looking forward to pleasant evenings with friends around a bonfire, or maybe you have some brush that needs burning. If so, don't forget to get a burning permit. Permits are available at the Greenwood Township Office. There is no fee for the permit and it is good for a whole year.

The permit helps the fire department keep track of burning in the township. It includes a packet of information explaining Greenwood Township's burning ordinances, such as what materials may and may not be burned, what kind of containers may be used, and acceptable hours for burning. The packet also lists the names and numbers of fire department officials to be notified of any burning you plan to do.
