

June 9, 2015
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on June 9, 2015 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 8 residents. The minutes of the previous Special meeting of the Election Commission on April 14, 2015 and the Special meeting on May 28, 2015 were approved as presented. The minutes from the May 12, 2015 were approved with the correction to change roll call vote to 3-1.

In correspondence Gill announced the St Clair County Road Commission meeting at the Township hall on June 16, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department Report was accepted as presented.

The enforcement officer's report was accepted as presented.

In citizens' comments there was discussion regarding the Township land purchase and clean up of the property.

In new business Gill announced that Greenwood Little League would like to use 2 ball fields for 6 Sundays for Fall Ball. They will pay the rental fee each week plus a deposit that will be returned at the end of the season. The hall will still be available to residents for rentals. Stewart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2015-5 Adopting Freedom of Information Act Procedures and Guidelines and Public Summary of FOIA Procedures and Guidelines. Supported by O'Brien. Roll call: Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Jonseck – yes; O'Brien – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to hire Kevin Lovik Builders to repair 4 bleachers. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. O'Brien made a motion to approve the 2015 Request for Local Millage Distribution from the St Clair County Parks and Recreation Commission. Jonseck seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; O'Brien – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to purchase two picnic tables and a garbage can. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to hire Nutech Solutions, Inc. to repair a crack in the concrete at the front door of the Township. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to have fascia installed around building and seal any gaps. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to approve the renewal of Michigan Township Association dues for 2015-2016. It was decided by the board to get estimates regarding the clean up of the newly purchased property.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
