

**August 11, 2015**  
**Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on August 11, 2015 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 11 residents. Treasurer Ramsey was absent. Also present were Curtis McBride and Crystal John from McBride-Manley & Company PC. The minutes of the previous Regular meeting on July 14, 2015 and the Special meeting on July 21, 2015 were approved as presented. A budget amendment under new business as an addition to the agenda was added by Gill.

In correspondence Gill discussed a letter she received from Stabenow & Peters regarding the Canadian Nuclear Storage.

The treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Stewart made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The Fire Department Report was accepted as presented.

The Enforcement Officer's Report was accepted as presented.

The Zoning Administrator discussed the Special meeting of the Planning Commission on August 5, 2015.

In citizens' comments questions were asked regarding a fire reported to Kenockee Township Fire Department and the issuance of a ticket for an illegal burn. A resident had questions regarding the ordinance for livestock count and the amount of land required.

In new business Curtis McBride from the auditing firm McBride & Manley was present to discuss the Greenwood Township audit performed this year. Curtis discussed the auditing process and announced that Greenwood Township received a Clean Opinion which is the highest rating the Township can receive. The agenda item for the Local Road Funding Resolution will be discussed at the next meeting. O'Brien made a motion to amend the budget in the amount of \$2,900.00 from Grounds Maintenance to Capital Outlay-Land. Stewart seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; O'Brien – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 4-0.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
