Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on July 14, 2015 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Treasurer Ramsey, Clerk O'Brien and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 9 residents. The minutes of the previous Regular meeting on June 9, 2015 and the Special meeting on July 9, 2015 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Jonseck made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department Report was accepted as presented.

The Zoning Administrator discussed being contacted by Nova regarding a solar farm on DTE property. There will be a future special meeting for the Planning Commission for site plan review.

In citizens' comments there was discussion regarding the Township Ordinance regarding small farm animals in a residential area.

In new business Stewart made a motion to approve a contract with the St Clair County Road Commission to replace a culvert on Kilgore Road between Lohr and Oatman. O'Brien seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to purchase a copier for the Township from Standard Office. Stewart seconding. Roll Call: Gill – yes; Jonseck – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to contract with C & A Construction to clean up the property purchased by the Township on Fargo Road. Stewart seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – no; Gill – yes; O'Brien – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes. Motion carried 4-1.

In citizens' comments Pete Bullard expressed appreciation to Greenwood Township for the use of the park for Greenwood Little League. A resident asked what the process was to change a Township Ordinance.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
