Greenwood Township
Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular Greenwood Township Board Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk Jonseck, Treasurer Trombley, and Trustee Vincent. Trustee Kaltz was absent. Thirteen residents were also present. The minutes from the regular meetings on August 11, 2009 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Trombley. Outstanding bills were presented by Jonseck with Vincent making a motion to pay the monthly bills, Trombley seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

Vincent presented the fire department report for the month of August. In Greenwood Township there were 5 medicals and 1 fire. In Kenockee Township there were 10 fires and 1 personal injury for a combined total of 17 runs for the month. Vincent also informed board members that the refrigerator for the fire hall was not working. The fire department purchased a used refrigerator for \$ 100 plus an additional \$115 for repairs. Vincent sought approval to be able to purchase a new refrigerator as a last resort only if the used refrigerator could not be fixed. A township resident also volunteered to donate a used refrigerator if the fire department needed it. The board decided to have the used refrigerator fixed first, if it could not be fixed to accept the donated refrigerator from the township resident, and as a last resort only to purchase a new refrigerator. Vincent made a motion that if needed the fire department could purchase a new refrigerator not to exceed \$600, Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The Zoning Administrator informed board members and residents that Glen Pape will be available to talk to residents about small energy wind systems for personal use on October 14th between the hours of 7 -9 pm at the township hall. The board also approved the Zoning Administrator's request to place a notice for this in The Yale Expositor.

In citizen's comment one resident inquired as to why the Ordinance Enforcement Officer was still coming to his property. Much discussion was held and the Zoning Administrator stated she would sit down with him personally and get together all the information needed so the resident can resolve this matter.

In new business Gill made a motion to appoint Pete Bullard to the Zoning Board of Appeals as an alternate, Trombley seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The board also gave permission to Supervisor Gill to sign and mail a letter to the Marine City Planning Commission to express the township's support to approve the application to rezone the deep water dock owned by the St. Clair County Road Commission, located within Marine City.
