Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 4 residents. The minutes from the regular meeting on July 9, 2013 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

In correspondence Gill discussed the Karegnondi water line project on Fisher Road. The project is expected to begin the end of Spring 2014. Stewart discussed replacing the LCD Computer Monitor as an emergency expenditure.

Ramsey made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The enforcement officer's report was approved as presented.

The Zoning Administrator was present to discuss a complaint regarding a swimming pool which will be corrected by the homeowner.

In new business Gill discussed expanding the park to include a basketball/tennis court combination and to begin planning walking trails. The Board will present quotes for the proposed projects at the September Regular meeting for discussion. Jonseck made a motion to approve six road contracts for ditching projects. Stewart seconding. Jonseck made a motion to purchase Building Department Field Correction Notices from Parkside Printing. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion for Clerk O'Brien to attend the Quarterly Luncheon for the St Clair County Clerks Association on September 12, 2013.

In citizens comments a resident asked about the ITC Line.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
