

November 12, 2013
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Clerk O'Brien at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 6 residents. Clerk O'Brien made a motion to allow Trustee Stewart to conduct the meeting in the absence of Supervisor Gill. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0. The minutes from the regular meeting on October 8, 2013 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

O'Brien made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

The fire department report was accepted as presented.

In correspondence Stewart announced that the Karegnondi Water Authority has a public meeting on November 20, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. Stewart announced that the information was dropped off by the Drain Commission regarding the Fueslein Drain Project.

The Zoning Administrator was present to discuss a possible revision to the sign ordinance at the next Planning Commission meeting.

In citizens comments a resident was present to discuss concern regarding the cleanup of the demolished building on Fargo Road. A resident asked about the current sign ordinance.

In old business Stewart discussed that Waterway has performed the hose testing on the fire truck and that she is waiting on Waterway to send the results. Stewart made a motion to table the discussion regarding additional hose request by Kenockee Fire Chief Keith Berg. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

In new business O'Brien made a motion to hire R&R Fire Truck Repair, Inc. to repair switches on fire truck, replace filters for generators and repair Akron Drain Valve. Ramsey seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; O'Brien. Motion carried 4-0. Jonseck made a motion to purchase a shut off valve to repair leak in water hose. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Stewart made a motion to table discussion regarding replacement of fluorescent bulbs in Fire Hall. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 4-0. Stewart made a motion to approve Ameriscapes to apply grass seed to new ball field contingent to receiving a guarantee from Ameriscapes of seed growth. Jonseck seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Stewart – yes; Ramsey – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 4-0.

In citizens comments a resident discussed the possibility of donating unusable fire hose to fire departments that are in need of equipment.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 4-0.
