

October 8, 2013
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 9 residents. Attorney James Dubay was also present to answer questions. The minutes from the regular meeting on September 10, 2013 and the minutes from the special meeting on September 16, 2013 were approved as presented.

In correspondence Gill announced that the renewal contract from Waste Management has been received. Gill also announced that a letter has been received in the Township from the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Stewart made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The fire department report was accepted as presented.

The Enforcement officer's report was accepted as presented.

Stewart reminded residents there is a Planning Commission meeting on October 16, 2013 at 7:30 p.m.. Stewart also announced that the Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals classes at the County have been canceled for October.

In citizens comments a resident had questions regarding a ditching project going north on Brown Road beginning at Jeddo Road. The resident is concerned that the ditching will interfere with his property. Gill suggested that the resident speak to the St Clair County Road Commission and she will also speak to them regarding the situation. A resident had questions regarding correspondence that he received from the St Clair County Drain Commission for the Fueslein Drain. Gill suggested that the resident call the Drain Office directly because the Fueslein Drain is a project being done by them. Gill also urged all residents to attend the day of review on November 7, 2013. A resident discussed the double culvert being installed at the intersection of Brown Road and Yale Road.

In new business Attorney James Dubay was present to discuss the unsafe property on Fargo Road. James Dubay discussed the options for the Township. Gill made a motion for a Budget Amendment from Drains at Large to Recreation for the Recreation Expansion. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0. O'Brien made a motion for a Budget Amendment from the Township Miscellaneous account into Cemetery. Sand needs to be added to some low spots in the cemetery and possibly one more mow. Gill seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to contract with Waterway of Michigan, LLC to conduct hose testing for the township fire truck. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to approve Zoning Administrator Arlene Johnson to issue addresses to new residents in Greenwood Township for a fee of \$25.00 per address. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments a resident complained about not receiving a response from the assessors.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
