

September 10, 2013
Greenwood Township – Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 5 residents. The minutes from the regular meeting on August 13, 2013.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

Stewart made a motion to approve the bills as presented. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Gill announced there will be a Planning Commission meeting on October 16, 2013 at 7:30 p.m.

In old business Patrick Greve from Waste Management was present to discuss the renewal of the 5 year contract with Greenwood Township. Gill made a motion to accept a 5 year renewal contract with Waste Management at a lower rate per household than we are currently paying and a change in the fuel surcharge. Stewart seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart discussed proposals received regarding the expansion of the Greenwood Township park. Gill made a motion to hire Huron Ecologic for an inspection of the portion of park property for placement of ball diamond. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill recommends calling a special meeting once the inspection by Huron Ecologic is complete.

In new business Stewart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2013-1 – St. Clair County Road Commission Local Road System Funding Assistance Program. Ramsey seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Kay Cumbow was present to discuss Greenwood Township approving a resolution regarding Nuclear Waste in Canada. Stewart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2013-2 Protesting the Construction of the Nuclear Waste Repository in the Great Lakes Basin in Canada. Ramsey seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart made a motion to hire R&R Fire Truck Repair, Inc. for the annual maintenance and pump test for Truck #36. O'Brien seconding. Roll call: Jonseck – yes; Gill – yes; Ramsey – yes; Stewart – yes; O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments a resident asked about submitting an estimate for construction of tennis court.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
