

December 9, 2014
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on December 9, 2014 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 6 residents. The minutes of the previous meeting on November 11, 2014 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

O'Brien made a motion to approve the outstanding bills with an additional bill from Apparatus Central Repair. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

A discussion was held regarding the springs on the fire truck. The springs were inspected by Bob's Truck and Equipment Repair and were determined to be a non-issue, very common and not a safety concern. Therefore, it was decided by the board that no action was needed.

Gill discussed enforcement issues in the Township.

In new business Gill made a motion to reappoint Doug Nowicki to Planning Commission for a 3 year term. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to reappoint Doug Nowicki and Debra Dams to Zoning Board of Appeals for a 3 year term. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to reappoint Bette Donaldson, Mike Walsh, Mark Begerowski, Robert Carrier as an alternate and Scott Ramsey as an alternate. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion for all Board of Review members, Board of Review alternates, Board Members and Assessors to attend Board of Review Training on February 19, 2015. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve an accident claim that occurred on election day. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve Birchler Arroyo as the new Planning and Zoning Consultants on an on-call and hourly payment for Greenwood Township. Ramsey seconding. Roll Call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, Stewart – yes, O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments a resident stated that the ditching looks good and has helped with the roads. A citizen complained that Hewitt Road is being destroyed by speeding vehicles.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding.

Meeting adjourned at 8:04 p.m.
