

**May 13, 2014**  
**Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes**

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on May 13, 2014 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 2 residents.

Gill requested to add Cemetery discussion under new business and repair of lights at the fire hall. It was approved by the board to make additions to the agenda.

The minutes from the regular meeting on April 8, 2014 were approved as presented.

In correspondence Gill announced that there will be a meeting on May 21, 2014 at 2:00 p.m. at Worth Township Hall regarding the Karegnondi Water Authority. Gill announced there will be a meeting on July 3, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. regarding the St Clair County ORV Ordinance. Gill announced that Greenwood Township received a letter from the St Clair County Drain Office stating that neither Greenwood Township nor Greenwood Township residents will be responsible for the emergency culvert replacement connected to the Fueslein Drain. Stewart announced that Greenwood Little League paid for Ameriscapes to build a pitching mound on the new diamond and that little league has installed fence protection.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey.

O'Brien made a motion to approve the outstanding bills as presented with Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Fire Department report was approved as presented. The repair of emergency lights at the fire hall will be discussed at the next regular board meeting in order to do more research.

Gill announced that she attended a hearing with the Magistrate regarding a current enforcement issue. The Magistrate will revisit the issue again in June 2014.

In citizens comments a resident discussed ITC.

In new business the board discussed the walking trails for the park. After much discussion it was decided to meet with Todd Burtch from the Road Commission, Todd Hess from Hess Asphalt and board members to walk the area. The board anticipates having multiple options and bid specifications for the trails at the next regular board meeting. Gill made a motion to purchase one poll booth. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Ramsey made a motion to have the road commission deliver and grade gravel in the township parking lot for the amount of \$400.00. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0. Gill requested that the township pay for the survey and title search, if necessary, of the Letts cemetery that the Dankenbrings would like to give to Greenwood Township. Stewart made a motion. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizen's comments the Karegnondi water line and the St Clair County ORV ordinance were discussed.

Ramsey made a motion to adjourn, with Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
