

January 13, 2015
Greenwood Township –Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees on January 13, 2015 was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:30 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 4 residents. The minutes of the previous meeting on December 9, 2014 were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report was read by Ramsey and approved.

In correspondence Gill discussed letters sent by the Enforcement Officer.

Jonseck made a motion to approve the outstanding bills. Ramsey seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

The Enforcement Officer's Report was approved as presented.

Gill discussed the upcoming Planning Commission meeting on January 21, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. and possible changes to the Zoning Board of Appeals meeting date.

In new business O'Brien offered Ordinance 2015-1 to amend Ordinance 79-1 Regulation, Licensing and control of assemblage of large numbers of people to designate violations as municipal civil infractions. Supported by Stewart. Roll call: Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Ramsey – yes, Stewart – yes, O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill offered Ordinance 2015-2 to amend Ordinance 1-94 Acquisition and posting of address numbers to designate violations as municipal civil infractions. Supported by Jonseck. Roll call: Gill – yes, Jonseck – yes, Ramsey – yes, Stewart – yes, O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart offered Ordinance 2015-3 to amend 2001-1 Greenwood Township Truck Ordinance to designate violations as municipal civil infractions. Supported by Ramsey. Roll call: Ramsey – yes, Jonseck – yes, Gill – yes, Stewart – yes, O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Stewart offered Resolution 2015-1 Township Policy for enforcement and penalties of/for Greenwood Township Ordinances under Michigan Municipal Civil Infraction Laws. Supported by Jonseck. Roll call: Stewart – yes, Gill – yes, Jonseck – yes, Ramsey – yes, O'Brien – yes. Motion carried 5-0. Gill made a motion to approve Township Board Members to attend 2015 St Clair County Chapter of the MTA Annual Dinner Meeting. O'Brien seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

In citizens comments residents discussed mail boxes being hit, trucks travelling on various roads. O'Brien announced that the State has called for a State Special Election on May 5, 2015 that will be held in Greenwood Township.

Jonseck made a motion to adjourn. Ramsey seconding.
