Greenwood Township – Special Meeting Minutes

The special meeting of the Greenwood Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Terry Gill at 7:00 p.m. at the Greenwood Township Hall, 9025 Yale Road. Other board members present were Clerk O'Brien, Treasurer Ramsey, and Trustees Jonseck and Stewart along with 26 residents. Also present were Kenosha Supervisor Keith Ward, Kenosha Clerk Sanford Fuller, Kenosha Trustees Harry Mericle and Rick Francek, Kenosha Fire Chief Keith Berg, Brockway Supervisor Bill McMurtrie, Brockway Clerk Bob Kammer, Brockway Fire Chief Dave Fredrick, and Attorney James Dubay.

Only two things were on the agenda. 1. possible appointment of an alternate member to the Board of Review and 2. discussion of an possible action on fire contract proposals.

Supervisor Gill addressed the issue regarding the fire hall. Gill stated that the issue being discussed was fire department proposals and that the fire hall would not be affected.

Gill made a motion to appoint Scott Ramsey as an alternate on Board of Review. Stewart seconding. Motion carried 5-0.

Proposals for fire and medical services were discussed from Brockway Township, Kenosha Township and the City of Yale. No action was taken.

Public comment was heard throughout regarding fire and medical response, equipment, and response times.

It was decided that a special meeting will be held on March 22, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. to further discuss fire proposals and possibly take action.

Gill made a motion to adjourn. Jonseck seconding. Motion carried 5-0.
